## Will a Ridge Vent System Keep Out the Bad Weather?

Before you are about to cut a slot into your roof for air to circulate freely, you may have a question about weather infiltration. Rest assured that ridge vent products are designed to keep wind, rain and snow, as well as insects, out of your attic. For example, Roll Vent consists of a three-dimensional open nylon matrix bonded to a breathable nylon-polyester non-woven fabric. This design prevents the possibility of leakage commonly seen with other venting devices. Roll Vent has been independently tested and has successfully withstood driving 110 mph winds and a continuous water spray equal to eight-inch per hour rains.
